Meeting premises

The Meeting will take place at the Danish Environmental Protection Agency. The address is Strandgade 29, 1401 Kbh. K. You will get information about the conference room at the reception.

Accommodation

As the Environmental Protection Agency is situated in the centre of Copenhagen, there is a variety of hotels not far from the meeting venue. We do not have any recommendations for specific hotels, and suggest that you have a look at one of the hotel booking portals on the internet.

Local transport

Metro

The Copenhagen Metro runs frequently from the airport to Christianshavn station, which is a 10 minute walk from the Environmental Protection Agency. Tickets can be purchased at the airport. You will need a 3-zone single ticket to go the city centre (including Christianshavn). The ticket price is DKK 36.

Please note, that there is no metro station at the Copenhagen central station. If you travel to Copenhagen by train from/via Sweden, it may be easier for you to get off at the airport rather than at the central station. It depends on whether you wish to continue your travel by metro or by taxi.

Taxi

The taxi fare from the airport to Christianshavn is approximately DKK 200.

The taxi fare from Copenhagen central station ("Hovedbanegården") to the Environmental Protection Agency is a little less than DKK 100.
