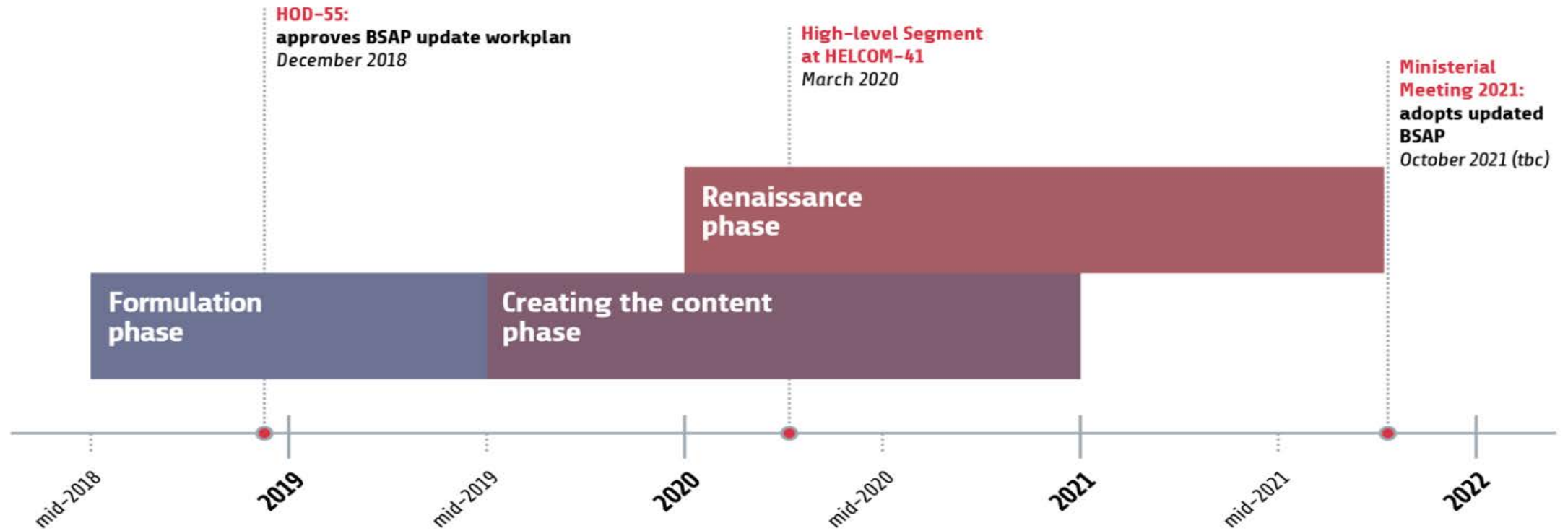

-  a healthy Baltic Sea environment with diverse biological components functioning in balance, resulting in a good ecological status and supporting a wide range of sustainable economic and social activities.

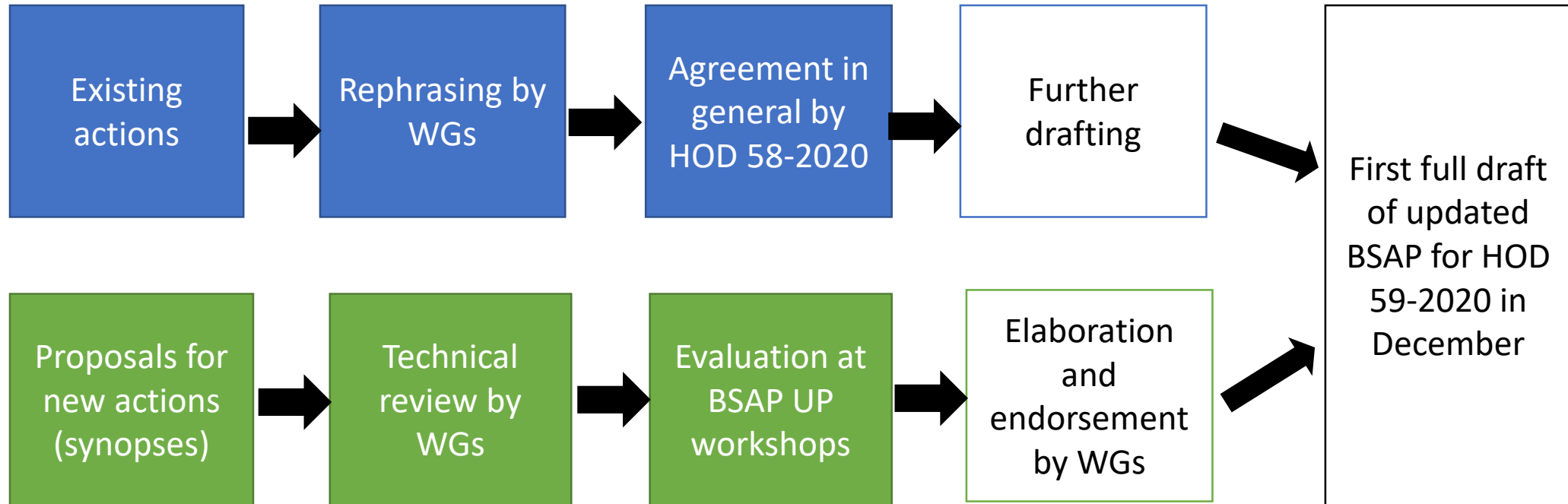
Goal

Aims of the workshop

 - Finding the final formulation for the proposed new actions is not a priority at the workshops. At a later stage, the proposed measures may have to be reformulated to a more general shape to fit the updated BSAP.
- Time allowing, identify gaps in the set of measures and exchange views on their sufficiency to achieve the BSAP goals.
