Background

According to the [Regional Baltic Marine Spatial Planning Roadmap 2013-2020](#) (point 4.1) and the [HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG Work Plan 2014-2016](#) the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG is to identify competent contact points for MSP for the purpose of transboundary consultation and joint planning.
