# Use of results of the cost-effectiveness analysis

- Time constraints and delays
- First attempt, uncertainties are high
  - Some proposed new actions lack detailed descriptions
  - Cost information
- Review and evaluation of results by CPs has not been possible
- Not advisable to use for selecting measures
- Indicative information to countries on effects and costs of new measures
- Information if the new measures address the pressures and state components that have gaps based on SOM

- Review by Contracting Parties in January 2021
- Small edits by project partners
- Submission to EU in February 2021
