Port Reception Facilities in the EU:

Directive 2000/59/EC

"Evaluation is an integral part of the Commission's effort to maximise the benefits and minimise the costs of EU policies,..."

1. Background

- **Adequate PRF required by MARPOL 73/78**
- **To fulfil this obligation at EU level:**
 - Directive 2000/59/EC on port reception facilities for ship-generated waste and cargo residues
 - Directive 2005/35/EU on ship source pollution and penalties for infringements
 - COM(2009)8 sets out long-term objective of zero-waste maritime transport
- **Directive 2000/59/EC provides for additional obligations and mechanisms to ensure the effective implementation and enforcement of the MARPOL requirements**

2. Assessment of the Implementation

- **Implementation/Status Reports MS**
- **Workshops, discussions, studies (EMSA)**
- **Monitoring in 22 MS – overall evaluation:**
 - PRF are generally available in EU ports
 - The volume of waste delivered in EU ports has increased with the implementation of the Directive
 - Waste management in ports has improved leading to reduced quantities of waste discharged at sea
 - Large variety of cost recovery systems in place

- **Areas for improvement:**

Waste Reception and Handling Plans

Enforcement

Availability and adequacy of PRF

3. Ex-post Evaluation

- **Commission Communication on Regulatory Fitness (REFIT): "evaluate first" policy (COM 2012/0746 fin.)**
- **Evaluation study: launched in July, contractor: PwC/Panteia BV**
- **Steering Group: COM (MOVE, ENV, SG, MARE), EMSA,**
- **Stakeholder Platform: ESSF / Expert Group**

4. Focus of the Evaluation

- **17 evaluation questions: Relevance, Effectiveness, Efficiency, European added value, Coherence**
- **Impact of the Mandatory delivery of SGW**
- **Adequacy and availability of PRF**
- **Functioning of the Enforcement Regime**
- **Data collection: changes in delivery patterns (volumes and types of waste)**

5. Evaluation Process

- 1. Evaluation Framework (Inception Report)**
- 2. Stakeholder Consultation:**
 1. Questionnaires:
 - 1.4 stakeholder groups (PA, WO, PU, NA),
 - 2.7 sections (identification/general, facilities, control procedures, enforcement, impacts, cost recovery systems, horizontal issues)
 2. Interviews
- 3. Desk research and analysis**
- 4. Reporting and presentation results**
