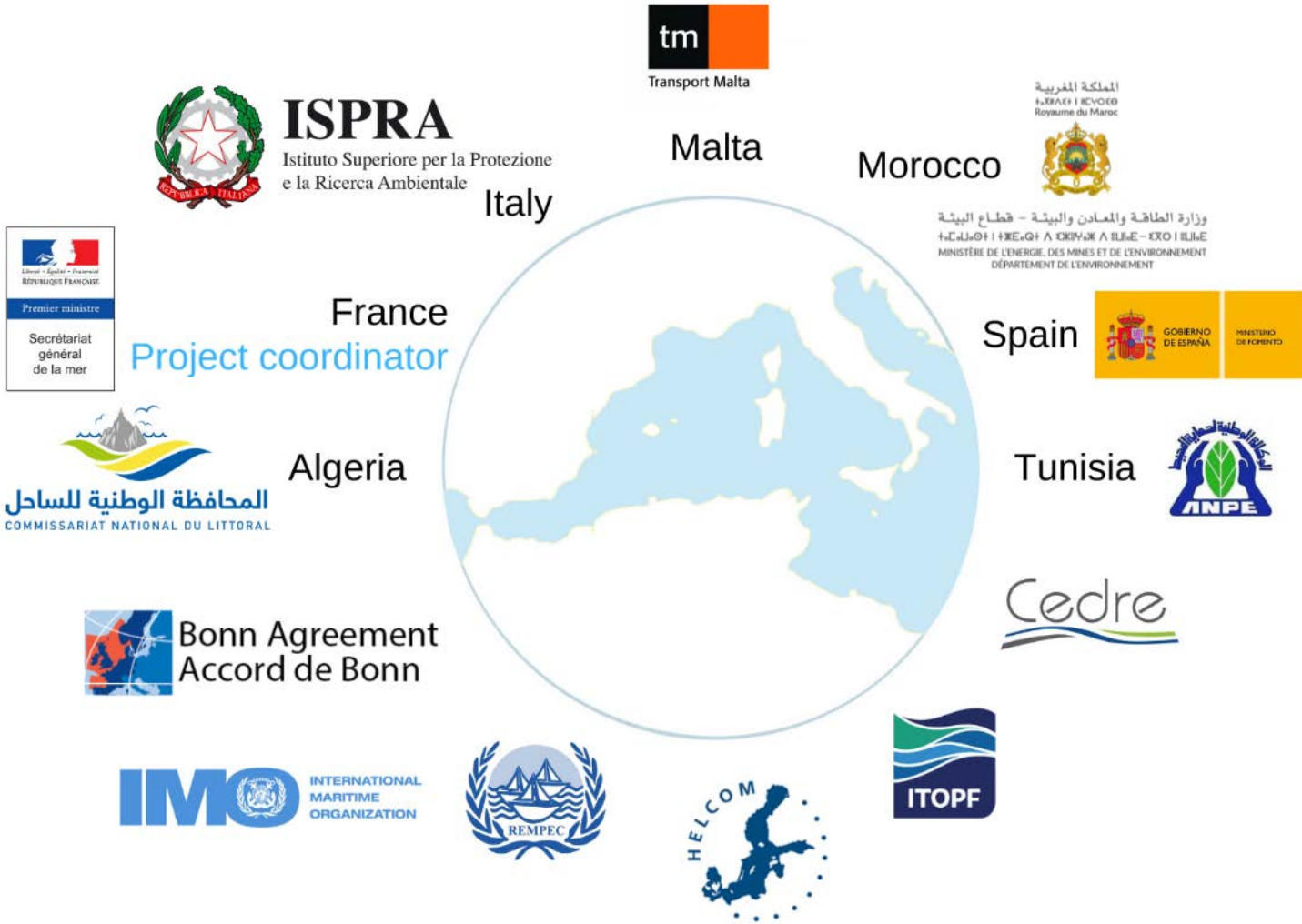

WP3.1: working phases

- From **April 2019 to December 2020**
- **Deliverable:** PDF format downloadable from the WestMOPoCo website
- **First phase:** adoption of the methodology to develop the Manual
 - Meeting between Cedre, ITOPF and ISPRA held in ITOPF's premises, April 2019
 - Approval of the working methodology and Manual content, June 2019



WP3.1: working phases

- **Second phase (from July 2019 to January 2020)**
 - Detailed Manual structure and content definition
 - Definition of a first list of operational sheets
 - Research of cases studies, pictures, schemes
 - Writing of section 2 of part 1 of the Manual / Writing of first operational sheets
 - Definition of the layout of the Manual
- **Third phase (from March to May 2020)**
 - Continue of the writing process and the research of cases studies, pictures, schemes
 - Integration of comments from HELCOM meeting participants
 - Intermediate validation during next Bonn Agreement meeting (May 2020)
- **Fourth phase (from June to October 2020)**
 - End of writing process
 - Intermediate validation during WestMOPoCo conference in Monaco (October 2020)
- **Fifth phase (from October to December 2020)**
 - Desktop publishing and dissemination

Reminder of the approved specifications of the

Marine HNS response manual

REMPEC, HELCOM and Bonn Agreement

- User-friendly and self-standing manual: use of illustrative pictures, drawings and schema
- Interactive document with intralinks and weblinks
- Side tabs for quick access to relevant information
- Same format as Transport Canada Manual
- 1 example of response per category of product behaviour
- Homogeneous specification of each response sheet: number of words, schema/picture, to do/not to do

Reminder of the structure of the Manual

Part 1 section 2 to be reviewed

Points for consideration

- to make comments on:
 - the content of the section 2 part 1 of the Manual: level of information...
- to suggest:
 - chemical substances or passed incidents to deal with, etc.
 - relevant illustrations (schemas, pictures, etc.) to introduce in the manual,
 - content to implement the third part of the Manual related to regional specificities
- to comment:
 - the user-friendly
 - the first layout

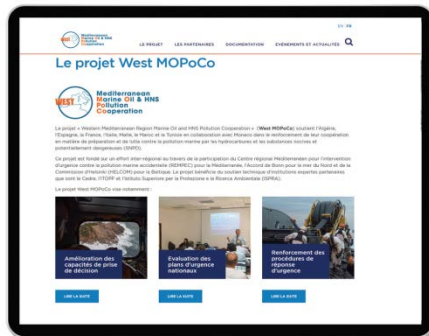
